MUNICIPALITY: Town of Oyster Bay

LOCATION: 10 Cherry Avenue, Bethpage, New York

Project Description:

This project was a joint venture between the Town of Oyster Bay and the Bethpage School District. The existing sports complex was completely rebuilt in two phases. The first phase included the construction of a new running track complete with field events and a multi-purpose synthetic-turf field. Construction started in mid-June 2009 and despite one of the rainiest months in recent years, the work was completed on time in the beginning of the school year. The second phase began after the football season and included the installation of stadium bleachers with press box, visitor bleachers, plaza area, and comfort station.



Project Elements:

- Multi-purpose synthetic-turf field with alternating-turf pattern
- Six-lane regulation size track, field events and poured resilient-track surfacing
- Perimeter fencing and removable lacrosse safety netting
- Self-contained site storm-water collection system
- Custom scoreboard and equipment-storage building
- Utility building with electric service
- Musco sports-lighting system, security lighting, cameras and speakers
- ADA-accessible stadium bleachers with press box and roof-viewing platform and visitor grandstand
- Precast concrete restroom, concession and storage building
- Decorative block wall, landscaping and irrigation
- Decorative paver plaza area with picnic tables
